

Readme for Cogo software

Installation

The installation program will automatically open the default CAD program (AutoCAD or IntelliCAD) and load the CogoSoftware menus into it.

The next time you start the default CAD program the CogoSoftware menus will be there.

Load Menus Manually

If the installation program was not able to load the CogoSoftware menus into the cad program you are using, you can load them manually.

To load the new menu and toolbars, start AutoCAD or IntelliCAD(CADian), open windows explorer.

Browse to the directory where you installed the program. (The default directory is: c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\Dpcogo)

Now drag the following file into your drawing: aCogoPkgLoader.lsp

NOTE:

The above aCogoPkgLoader.lsp files will add our program paths to the default search path.

If the program gives you an error that it cannot find something then you will need to manually add the paths.

Go to Tools -- Config...

Add the following paths to the AutoCAD or IntelliCAD search paths:

(assumes the default installation)

c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\dpcogo

c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\dpcogo\dwglib

c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\dpcogo\toolbar

c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\dpdtm

c:\Program Files\CogoSoftware\dproad
